## The God who 'is': Exodus 3

Read Exodus 3 and pray that God would be at work by his Spirit during your time together.

1) How would you describe what God is like?

2) The Christian Minister Jim Packer wrote in his book Knowing God, "We are pygmy Christians because we have a pygmy God." What do you think he means? Why do you think it matters so much to have a right view of what God is like?

3) In many ways God has been on the sidelines in Exodus 1 and 2. In chapter 3 God bursts onto the scene as he reveals himself to Moses. What do we find out about what God is like in verses 4-6?

4) Look at verses 7-10. What do we find out about what God is like in these verses?

5) God reveals himself as both above us and among us. He is above us - he is glorious, powerful, majestic, holy and far greater than we can grasp. To meet him face to face is an awesome thing. He is also among us - he hears us, sees us and is concerned for us. He loves us and draws near to us in grace and compassion. Why do you think it's important that we hold onto both of these truths?

6) Exodus is all about God rescuing his people from slavery to bring them into the freedom of living and worshipping him, to dwell with him. God rescues us for relationship with him; to know and love him. How does what you've seen of God's character encourage you to want to know him better?
