Read Exodus 12:1-32. Pray that God's Spirit would help you to understand and apply the passage to your own lives.

- 1) In the passage God's people are to kill a lamb and paint its blood on their doorframes. Why is this necessary? What does it tell us about the Israelites?
- 2) Was there anything special about the blood?
- 3) What did the blood on the door posts prove about the people in that house?
- 4) How do these events foreshadow Jesus' sacrifice on the cross?
- 5) What can we learn from the Israelites' response to God's instructions?
- 6) How does understanding the events of this passage deepen your appreciation for God's deliverance in your own life?
- 7) What things are the Israelites to do in response to God's instructions?
- 8) How can we worship like the Israelites are instructed? What can we do to remember all that Jesus has done for us as our substitute?
