### Mark 9:2-13, Jesus in Glory

We started a new series on Sunday - The Servant King - looking at the second half of Mark's gospel.

1. Have a think and a share about the most some of the most amazing sights you've ever seen. Sights that made your jaw drop. Sights that left you in wide-eyed wonder.
2. Read Mark 9:2-13. What happens to Jesus up the mountain?
3. What does it tell us that Moses (the great law-giver) and Elijah (the great prophet) appear on the mountain with Jesus?
4. Have a look back at Mark 8:27-30 together. Why is what God says in chapter 9 verse 7 is particularly significant to Peter and the others?
5. In Matthew's account of this event (Matthew 17) it also describes Jesus' face, saying it shone like the sun. The transfiguration is an outward sign of the glory that was always in Jesus. What are some ways in which we might accidentally miss the full glory of Jesus?
6. How can we help ourselves to truly marvel and be awe-struck by the Lord Jesus?
7. What is the command given in verse 7?
8. What does listening to Jesus look like in your own life? Are there any ways we can be better at listening to Jesus?
